In Malaysia, Peranakan Chinese or Straits-born Chinese are the descendants of Chinese immigrants who came to the Malay Archipelago between the 15th and 17th centuries. They maintained their culture partially despite their native language gradually disappearing a few generations after settlement.

Members of this community in Malaysia address themselves as "Baba Nyonya." Nyonya is the term for the women and Baba for the men. Nyonyas and Babas usually do not speak Chinese, or other Chinese dialects. They have a language of their own. In their heyday, the Babas and Nyonyas were wealthy and influential people in the business world. This is evident in their jewelry costumes, shoes and embroidery pieces—items of refined workmanship highly sought after by art and antique collectors. They were usually traders, the middlemen of the British and the Chinese, or the Chinese and Malays. Because of this, they almost always had the ability to speak two or more languages.

The Nyonya dishes are a combination of Chinese and Malay dishes, giving it a distinct flavor of its own. Nyonya cooking is about the blending of spices. Although Peranakan food takes a long time to prepare, traditional Nyonyas are proud of their unique cuisine and spend a better part of their lives in the kitchen to prepare these dishes. The Peranakan food is one of the most popular contributions of the community to modern day Southeast Asians. Many Nyonya restaurants have opened all over Malaysia and Singapore in recent years.

Yet, despite of the adoption of various cultures in their daily life, Baba Nyonyas have clung to their Chinese identity in some aspects. They celebrate festivals like the Moon Festival on a large scale. The older generation continues to observe Chinese religious beliefs and rituals, though many younger Straits-born Chinese eventually convert to Christianity.
